1. Briefly summarize and clearly articulate the focus, purpose and intent of the service project. (100 Words max)

2. Identify how the service project will change or enhance instruction and impact student learning. (100 Words max)

3. Describe the timeline, goals and evaluation method for this service project. (200 words max).

4. Approximate number of students who will be directly impacted by the implementation of this service project.

5. Provide a detailed itemization of your service project budget request. (100 words max).

Note: *Products purchased through service project become the property of the Lee's Summit School District. It is expected that approved projects will be shared throughout the R-7 District and with Lee's Summit CARES.*
